Your Faithful Pre-Yom Tov Check List – Let's Get It Done!

- Iron Chef Eruv: As Shabbat again immediately follows the *YomTov* days, this Sukkot we'll need to once again set aside an *Eruv Tavshilin* which allows us to cook for Shabbat on Friday which is *Yom Tov*, and usually only allowed cooking for that day alone.
- Time to Throw in the Towel: Males can spiritually groom by immersing in the Mikvah. It's free for Shul members; non-members require a minimum \$10 donation. Unfamiliar with the steps? Contact Rabbi Yossi. And don't forget to bring your own towel!
- Major in Mishpacha Spirit: Remember to ensure that your Sukkah is clean, well lit and *Halachically* kosher so that the mitzvah can be performed properly. Invite neighbours and shul friends to share the beauty of our uniquely welcoming sacred tradition!

Outside We Are Free: The seventh day of Sukkot (*Hoshana Rabba*) Wed, Oct 11 is your last chance to alter any heavenly decrees and ensure a *G'mar Chatima Tova* for you, your loved ones and all of *Am Yisrael*. Many communities including ours gather to recite the entire book of *Tehillim* beginning after *Chatzot haLeila* (the *Halachik* midnight) early Wednesday morning, then we distribute apples & honey in the Sukkah. Note: Morning services are also significantly longer including multiple Hosha'anot: encircling the bima seven times with the lulav and then striking the ground with special *Arava* branches. Davening (both *Minyanim!*) begins at 6:35 am. Join us for one or both of these special prayer services and help ensure that this New Year is filled with sweetness and blessings!

- > 1:04 am Tehillim Recitation: "Seal the Deal" Unique nighttime recitation including 5 special prayers recited only once a year!
- > 6:35 am Shacharit Prayers: "Concurrent Options" 2 services; 1 swiftly in the Shtieble or moderately paced in the Beit Midrash
