Shabbat Morning ~ Sivan 12: The “Post-Shavuot” Conclusion – May 26 | סיום ימי התשלומין - שבת קודש י”ב סיון

Shavuot Nation - When our Holy Temple stood in Jerusalem, *Am Yisrael* would gather there for the **three annual pilgrimage festivals**: Passover, Shavuot and Sukkot. Sivan 12 was the last of the seven days allotted for the offerings brought with the Shavuot pilgrimage. Unlike Passover and Sukkot’s week-long celebration, Shavuot is just **one day**, hence an additional 6 days of *Tashlumin* or fulfillment was added. Honouring this, we don’t resume reciting *tachnun* (=penitential supplication), and the other prayers omitted on a festival or joyous commemoration, until after the 12th day of Sivan, because all these days maintain an extended connection with the festival of *Shavuot*.

- **8:30 am – Class: “Desert Storm”** Spiritual insights from 40 years of Sinai sojourns & Mishkan making in the desolate wilderness.
- **9:15 am – Sanctuary Services: “MS-13 Animals vs 613 Menchen?”** Inspirational *Davening*, meaningful melodies, insightful teachings and timely messages culled from this longest *Parsha* in the entire Torah and *Shavuot’s “Fulfillment Days”* that conclude this Shabbat!
