About Leibel - At only 19, Leibel Mangel left his home and family in Cincinnati, Ohio to enlist in the Israel Defense Forces as a lone soldier. Leibel, who grew up as the son of Chabad Shluchim and a grandson of Auschwitz's youngest survivor, the famed scholar and translator Rav Nissan Mangel, felt driven to serve in the IDF to ensure "Never Again." He participated in many high profile anti-terror operations including the discovery of the tragic kidnapped bodies of Gil-Ad Shaer, Naftali Fraenkel and Eyal Yifrah in 2014. Leibel has used his story and experiences to extend his service by advocating for Israel in mainstream and social media and by speaking to communities around the world. Leibel is also the recipient of a 2017 Jewish People's Choice Award.
