Parsha Snapshot: See Anything Lately?

Avraham sees G-d; but he rushes off to welcome guests, or disguised angels: "Next year, Sarah will give birth to a son. She laughs. Not cool!"

Avraham pleads to save Sodom, but the city is doomed. Lot welcomes the Angel/guests: "We've come to destroy but save you." In flight, his wife turns into a pillar of salt. Sheltered in a cave, Lot's daughters (believing they're the world's sole survivors) get their dad drunk and get pregnant. Oy! But this sordid incident will produce the nations of Moab and Ammon.

Avraham relocates, Sarah is royally abducted. G-d saves her. She's returned to her husband. Per G-d's promise; a son is born. Yitzchak brings laughter and joy; at 8 days old he's entered into the Brit Covenant.

Ishmael tries to kill the baby. He and his mom get the boot. G-d hears the cry of the dying lad. His life is saved. Peace happens in Be'er Sheva. The Akaida drama unfolds. Yitzchak is to be sacrificed on Mount Moriah. As Avraham raises the knife, a Heavenly voice intervenes and a ram, caught in the thicket, is offered instead. Mazal Tov! We hear that Rivka was born.
