Observing Hilula at Chabad

Wednesday is Chof Av, the 20th of *Menachem-Av*. The Talmud notes that this has been a venerated date ever since Temple times. Kabbalistically, it is linked both to *Rosh Hashanah* and the upcoming New Year. For us, as Chassidim of the Rebbe, it is the **Yahrzeit-Hilula of Rav Levi Yitzchok Schneerson**, the Rebbe's saintly father who was the faithful Torah Leader in Ukraine, defying the G-dless, demonic Soviet tyrants by keeping *Yiddishkeit* alive. Despite their arresting, torturing, and exiling him to a remote **gulag**; and, despite the suffering of inhumane conditions that tragically caused his premature death... **his spirit and legacy of Torah Teaching lives on**.
