The Handmade Tale: Matzah at the Seder – Eaten after nightfall (this year from 8:19pm onwards), actively nourishes faith in Hashem all year long. Ideally, **handmade Shmurah** should be used. We'll got a limited supply of for the discount price of **\$35.00/lb for Members and \$42.00/lb for Non-Members. Supplies are limited! Get it while it lasts!!**

Chametz: You Can't Own That! Possession of Chametz on Pesach is *strictly* prohibited by the Torah: by Halachik noon *Erev Pesach*, all your Chametz must be eaten, destroyed, or sold to a gentile. Our Rav arranges this sale on your behalf - for free, but there's a caveat - you must formally **appoint** him to do so! Fill out the Chametz Sale Form on paper or online. There's no fee, but donations to the Shul are welcome!!

Let's Get it Done: Here's a Passover at-a-glance Holiday to-do Checklist!

- ✓ **Maot Chitim: because Passover should be for All!** As we head towards Pesach, pause, and consider people in need. In a time-honoured-tradition, Rabbis discreetly collect and distribute funds for those who are unable to properly celebrate the holiday. Anyone wishing to anonymously assist needy individuals and families –during this time, is welcome to contact our Rav directly.
- ✓ **Sacred Removal: Shaimos @770** – For many, Pesach-cleaning and Spring-cleaning overlap. Disposal of sacred articles (such as worn out Tefillin, Mezuzot, Siddurim, Chumashim or *Chayenu* and *Bencher* pamphlets is available at **770 Chabad Gate**. There's a small cost; contact them at 905-731-7000 for info. **DO NOT** drop it here as it'll incur additional costs for our Shul.
- ✓ **COR Values** – Kashruth Council of Canada answers Pesach questions about products they certify and the kosher food industry in general. Direct Passover Kashrut queries to: Questions@cor.ca or use their **Text-A-Rabbi** service at (647) 402-1910.
- ✓ **Green Bin Depot** – We thank our **City Councilor, Gila Martow** for ensuring that Chametz disposal continues to happen in Vaughan. 5:30 am to 9:00 pm at the Garnet, 501 Clark Avenue W via the East Entrance.
